up addiction and depression to help children.

A Story Within The Story

While Marc's life story was being told, another drama was going on in the lives of the actors, our older students.

Brian (name changed) has been a student at CBC for several yeas and was in his last year at the project. A few months before Christmas he began to miss classes. When we asked around, rumours came back that he had become involved in drug dealing and had been seen in the area with an illegal weapon. Unfortunately this is extremely common in the streets around The University of Life.

We sent a message to his mother (Brian's father left the family and has no relationship with him) saying that we missed him and hoped he would talk to us. He agreed and we arranged a meeting with his teacher and with Adalberto, an alumni of the project.

During the meeting we explained to Brian how precious his life is, how talented he is and how much we value him as a student in the project. Brian was stunned with the care and compassion shown to him even though he had made some very bad decisions.

Adalberto explained to him how he himself had lost many friends due to violence in the slums and how painful this had been for him. He continued to encourage Brian to come back to the project and put his focus on studying and his energy into theatre which was his passion.

Brian shed many tears and felt a strong conviction to stop his involvement in drugs. Brian's decision was upheld with his daily commitment to return to The University of Life in the months before Christmas.

We hope and pray that Brian will succeed, he has so much potential and talent.

Young people like Brian are confronted with poverty everyday and gangs use this suffering to lure children into trafficking to make quick money and offer a false escape from reality.
