Jonah is 12 years old. He studies with us in the morning and at a nearby state school in the afternoon. He is new to the project this year but has quickly found his place and made friends. Jonah enjoys all the activities we offer, especially hip hop. He is an intelligent young man and with our encouragement, has written down his dreams for the future. He has told us that he wants to be a solicitor.

Jonah recently read the Biblical story bearing his name but didn't really like the ending. He wanted Biblical Jonah to be a bit more of a hero, and asked us, "Can I change the story?"

What a great question! Have you read the last chapter of Jonah recently? Biblical Jonah is left on a literal cliff hanger, overlooking the city of Nineveh, wondering how God can care so much for the city.

Not unlike the Biblical character, Jonah struggles. He was abandoned by his father and his young mother has been unable to raise him. Jonah's grandparents have been responsible for him since he was born. Jonah has been working through feel-

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ings of abandonment, resentment and anger toward his father. Surrounded by the loving care of our teachers, he has also felt the loss of not having his own mother's love and care.

Jonah is growing up in the slums surrounded by injustice and poverty, trying to figure things out. He feels alone and is asking, is there any hope?

In the Biblical story God says yes. He spared Jonah and Nineveh for another day. The challenge facing Biblical Jonah on the cliff top, is similar to the one facing our Jonah as he grows up in the slums. Biblical Jonah struggled, he made his own choices and things got messy, but God helped him get the job done.

The end of the Biblical story is unknown. Perhaps that is the point, Jonah had seen God's faithfulness in action and had to decide for himself. Jonah's question is brilliant. **In a sense, the answer is yes.**

Jonah can change his own story.

Because of your partnership, Jonah is beginning to feel that he is special, for the first time in his life. Together we are helping him develop his faith, navigate the difficult times and understand that no matter what happens God loves him and has plans for him that will change his life and God's world.

That's what being a Dreambuilder (monthly giver) is all about.
